Teaching Methods

Task-based language learning . The focus of the teaching is on the completion of a task which in itself is interesting to the learners. Learners use the language they already have to complete the task and there is little correction of errors. (This is the predominant method in middle school ESL teaching at Frankfurt International School.
